

Plastic Fire Extinguisher Cases

Recently, the Monterey Homeowner Association has replaced the old metal fire extinguisher cases with new plastic fire extinguisher cases throughout the community. In total, over 120 cases were purchased and placed at every building on the property including the fitness center, laundry facilities, and boiler room areas. The old metal fire extinguisher cases were removed for numerous reasons including rusting, glass shattering, paint fade and chipping, sharp corners, and the missing of breaker bars and hammers to access the fire extinguishers. The plastic fire extinguisher cases installed around the property are made out of high-impact polystyrene, ultra¬violet inhibitors, cylinder locks, and plastic injected molded hammers for access to the fire extinguisher cases. Instead of glass, these new plastic fire extinguisher cases use virgin acrylic plaskolite panel with scored lines for easy breakage with the plastic injected molded hammer for ease of access and no dangerous shards of acrylic.
